



Announcement of the Southern Border Provinces Administrative Centre
Subject: Intent Not Accepting Gifts and Gratuities of All Kinds for Performing Duties
(No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

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Based on the Cabinet Resolution dated 8 December B.E. 2563 (2020), the National Reform Plan on Preventing and Suppressing Corruption and Misconduct was approved. This plan stipulates a crucial reform activity, Activity 4: Developing the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and free from vested interests, with Target 1, Clause 1.1, which mandates that: "Every government agency shall declare itself an agency where all state officials shall not accept any gifts or gratuities from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)." This declaration serves as a strong commitment to combating all forms of corruption and misconduct, fostering moral and ethical conduct, and promoting integrity in the performance of duty, ultimately leading to transparency in the operations of agency personnel in accordance with good governance principles.

To implement this policy and strengthen the organization's culture of morality and transparent operations, therefore, the Secretary General of SBPAC hereby declares the intent of the SBPAC administration that the executives, civil servants, and all of officials' SBPAC will perform duties with honesty and integrity, and will not accept gifts and gratuities of all kinds whether received before, during, and after performing duties which could lead to misconduct and corruption in the present and future. This includes engaging and integrating in collaboration with all agencies to prevent and suppress corruption along with prioritizing on the public and the national interest.

This Announcement shall be duly informed and be strictly adhered to by all personnel.
